Policy name: Dress Code Policy

Date approved: December 2011

Purpose: to set standards for the attire to be worn by all players, and all coaches on the field and in the dugouts, for our Little League and T-ball divisions which includes House League games, tournaments (both home and away) and special events (e.g. Opening Day, Championship Day).

POLICY

Players

All players are expected to wear their league-supplied team jersey, league-supplied team hat and long baseball pants to all games. All players on a team are expected to be dressed in the same uniform for their games including socks. All players are expected to wear their jersey tucked into their baseball pants at all games. Attire at practices is up to the coach but all players must still wear long pants. No jewellery of any kind is permitted to be worn except that which identifies medical conditions. Baseball shoes are recommended. Sandals, flip flops, crocs etc. are not permitted.

Coaches

Coaches, both on-field and in the dugout, are expected to wear a league-supplied coach's shirt, a league-supplied hat and long pants at all games for both House League and Tournament play and special events when identified by the League Executive. It is recommended that the pants be presentable and not ripped jeans, track pants etc. Shorts are not permitted.

For tournaments, coaches are expected to decide on and abide by a consistent look for their team (i.e. similar style/colour) and have their shirts tucked in. Shorts are not permitted. At the District Championships, the pants must be a casual slack. Again, shorts are not permitted.
