## Minor and Major T-ball - House League Ground Rules

If there are any inconsistencies between these rules and the T-ball Rules of Play, the rules on this page are to be taken as correct.

### Number of defensive players

- The maximum number of defensive players in the field is 11.
- In Major T-ball, the minimum number of players is 8.
- There is no minimum in Minor T-ball.

### Call-Ups

- A Call-Up is when you ask a player on another team in the division below yours to join your team for a game.
- For Major T-ball, Call-Ups can be used if you suspect you are going to have less than 11 players at game time.
- There will be a list of Minor T-ball players to call up to your team. If there are no Minor T-ball players available from the list, then you may use a Call-Over.
- Coaches are responsible for finding their own Call-ups in accordance with the League's Call-up Policy.

### Call-Overs

- A Call-Over is when you ask a player on another team in the same division to join your team for a game. Call-Overs are not permitted for Playoff or Championship games.

### Game Sheets

- Game Sheets should always be used by both teams. Once the Playoffs begin in Major T-ball, Game Sheets must be retained by each team in the event the League asks to see them. Also, the final score of all Playoff games must be reported to the League by both teams.

### Fence

- If the ball bounces over or rolls under the fence, it is a ground rule double except on last batter in which case it is a ground rule triple.

### Outs

- In Minor T-ball, calling Outs is at the discretion of the coaches.
- In Major T-ball, all T-ball rules apply from the beginning of the season (except strikeouts – see below).

### Strikeouts

- There are no strikeouts in Minor T-ball.
- In Major T-ball, some latitude should be given to the players at the beginning of the season, but by about the mid-point, strikeouts will be called.

### Game Duration

- A House League T-ball game is 4 innings in length. No new inning can start after 1hr and 45min from the start of the game.
- Until school is out (that is, during May and most of June), all games, regardless of start time, should end so the players are heading home close to 8:00 pm.
